They have hook-ups for \$32.00 per night. The tiers cabin will be at Dave's trailer in Lower Twin Resort. The matuka and the green hornet will be the featured flies to be tied. June's Fishout could be a little iffy. We selected Lake Davis as first choice, with Frenchmans or Spooner as contingency venues. A Fishout for July may
